



**Salford's Lost Canal:
storytelling walk**

**Friday 20 August
11am and 2.30pm**



Explore the forgotten Manchester, Bolton and Bury Canal (so forgotten it doesn't mention Salford even though it runs through it!) and discover myths, stories and the collector

Meeting point: at the canal, off Park House Bridge Road, off Langley Road (see the blue triangle on the map below) – if you're late catch up with us by following the canal

The walk is free but please book a place by emailing ben.turner@walktheplank.co.uk / 07976 560 498 no later than **12noon Thurs 19 August**: we'll contact you in advance to ask you to bring something which can be left with the collector (more details to follow)

Each walk lasts for 90 minutes and is along a flat towpath. There are no toilets on site. There is limited on road parking at Park House Bridge Road and the walk will take place whatever the weather

The walk ends underneath the A6044 road bridge on Agecroft Road opposite the Dogs 4 Us pet place. From here you can either make your own way back to the start along the canal or continue down to the River Irwell and walk back that way
